

Children and their natural curiosity about the world is at the heart of the PSP at Edify School. Their existing questions and explorations of the world drive our units of inquiry and forms the bedrock on which our facilitators plan learning engagements that uniquely stimulate and challenge our **learners to discover the world on their own terms.**

Our learning and teaching practices are built around each learner's needs and recognize that meaningful and enduring learning takes place when supported by an active and responsive learning community.

At Edify School, our PSP students experience the power of collaboration everyday, and learn first-hand, what it means to have a global outlook.

Approaches to Learning & Teaching

At Edify School, students enjoy a range of opportunities, activities and learning experiences that help them develop thinking skills, research skills, social skills, communication skills and selfmanagement skills. Our teachers are trained to facilitate learning that is fuelled by inquiry, driven by concepts, and differentiated to meet unique learning needs. As part of a curious learning community, children learn early on how to construct knowledge with their peers, in a shared and collaborative journey that spans across local and global contexts.

Transdisciplinary Themes

Learning at Edify School is integrated, conceptually driven, connected and meaningful and this is made possible by the six transdisciplinary themes around which all learning is planned:

- Our Expressions
- World Laws
- Our Systems
- Our Responsibilities
- Our Identity
- The Place and Time

These transdisciplinary themes unite concepts, skills and knowledge from across six subject areas in varying combinations at each grade level:

- Language
- Social Studies
- Mathematics
- ArtsScience
- Personal, Social and Physical Education

International Mindedness

Through the PSP and the development of the attributes of 3C Profiles, young learners at Edify School develop a curiosity and deep appreciation for diverse perspectives and cultures, as well as the core human commonalities that underlie them. The curriculum and our approach to learning and teaching encourages our students to become global citizens who are multilingual, and understand the need for intercultural understanding. Our inquiry modules also invite students to take action through global engagement in a variety of modes.



Agency

With 3C curriculum, Edify School firmly believes that children learn best when their capacity to make decisions about what, how and why they learn is understood and valued. Children's agency- their voices, choices and sense of ownership is honoured and celebrated in our classrooms and learning spaces.

Action

Our educators understand that learning does not begin nor end in isolation in the classroom- its influence and implications are far-reaching and have the potential to have real-world impacts. At Edify School, each of our students are agents of change in their own right. Our classroom explorations regularly inspire our students to take action in the wider world through participation, advocacy, social justice, social entrepreneurship, and even life choices they make on a daily basis. In many ways, as a school, we measure the effectiveness of learning through the actions and choices our students make.

Exhibition

The PSP Exhibition is the culmination of each student's shared and personal learning journey through the eight years of the Primary School Programme. The PSP Exhibition is a vibrant wholeschool celebration of the tool-kit of concepts, skills and knowledge that students have acquired and mastered over the years. Students at other stages of their learning journey may also share their reflections through guided exhibitions or end of unit showcases in other grade levels.

Assessment

Both facilitators and students at Edify School, view assessment as a process that is inseparable from active, ongoing learning that helps make teachinglearning practices more effective and informed. Our educators use a range of tools such as rubrics, checklists, anecdotal records, continuums and exemplars to assess students' learning. Students also have opportunities to assess and reflect on their own learning as well as that of their peers. Learner Synopsis Day, Coffee Mornings, and exhibitions also involve the parent community in the assessment of learning.
